APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS

All applications are processed through the Membership Digital Portal which can be accessed via this link https://member.engineersrwanda.rw/home

Below are the mandatory application requirements needed to be registered in the category indicated above:

- 1. All applicants are required to have a proven professional experience of more than 2 years after graduation
- 2. A Passport-size photo in PNG or JPG Image format
- 3. A Scanned copy of a National ID or Passport in PNG or JPG image format
- 4. A Scanned copy of Notarized Diploma Certificate(Ao) in PNG or JPG Image format
- 5. A Soft copy of a signed Career Statement or CV in PDF format
- A Soft copy of an endorsed, signed, and stamped (by a Supervisor) copy of a Technical . Report
- 7. A Foreign Practicing License (Only for non-Rwandans)
- 8. Scanned copy of Notarized Degree Certificates in PNG or JPG image format
- A scanned copy of a Bank pay slip (to be submitted as an attachment through the Membership Portal) of non-refundable application fees amounting to Rwf 20,000 payable on Account No: 211-131222-1-5118-0 under the names of Institute of Engineers Rwanda in GT Bank (Rwanda) Plc or through MoMo pay *182*8*1*003884#

Note:

- Degrees from Foreign Countries need an equivalence certificate from the High Education Council (HEC)
- 2. After being admitted as a Professional Engineer with the Institution of Engineers Rwanda, an annual membership fee of Rwf 200,000 is required through the same payment modalities as provided above; if the applicant is Rwandan, a member of the East African Community Countries (Uganda, Kenya, Tanzania) with which IER has a Mutual Recognition Agreement. A Practicing License is issued, thereafter.

3. Nationals of Foreign Countries outside the East African Community and other countries of the East African Community with which IER does not have a Mutual Recognition Agreement with pay USD 500 through the payment modalities provided above. A Practicing License is issued, thereafter.
